NOTICE TO THE MEMBERS OF THE BAR SUPERIOR COURT – DISTRICT OF MONTRÉAL MODIFICATIONS TO THE COMMUNIQUÉ REVISED ON FEBRUARY 26, 2021

March 3, 2022 (Family Matters)

Certain measures announced in the Superior Court's Communiqué, revised on February 26, 2021, are clarified or replaced with the following measures:

1. 8:45 a.m. Roll of Courtroom 2.17

Article 128 of the *Directives de la Cour supérieure pour le district de Montréal (septembre 2019)* applies to the virtual call of the roll in Courtroom 2.17.

Therefore, between 8:45 a.m. and 9:00 a.m., it is possible for the attorneys and unrepresented parties to request from the special clerk presiding Courtroom 2.17 to have their file transferred to room 2.11 (Safeguard Orders) or 2.12 (family case management), providing that:

- The application is not contested; or
- The application is contested but all the attorneys and/or unrepresented parties are present and ready to proceed immediately;
- In the case where the file is transferred for case management, the application's heading will correspond to one of the subjects found at article 158 of the *Directives de la Cour supérieure pour le district de Montréal*

After 9:00 a.m., the transfer of the file will be decided according to order in which it appears on the roll.

Also, **between 8:45 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.**, it is possible for the attorneys and unrepresented parties to have the undertakings verified for the purpose of setting a hearing date.

2. Homologation or Renewal Request

As of March 14, 2022, the attorneys and unrepresented parties are invited to use the new form entitled "**Instructions for Homologation or Renewal Request**" accompanied by the consent and relevant documents for the filing of the instructions regarding the homologation of a consent or to the extension of a safeguard order, making the participation to the calling of the roll unnecessary.
