(BY ORDER OF THE COURT)
On, you confirmed to the Court that you agreed to act as the supervisor of access rights. An <b>access right</b> is an order from the Court allowing a parent to see his or her child or children on certain conditions. The " <b>exercise of an access right</b> " is the time when the parent sees his or her child or children.
By agreeing to act as the supervisor of access rights, you undertake:
<ul> <li>to be present at all exercises of the access right;</li> <li>to be present at all times during exercise of the access right.</li> </ul>
You cannot choose to cease acting as the supervisor of access rights, and you cannot be replaced by another person at your own convenience.
If you are no longer able or willing to act as the supervisor of access rights, you must notify both parents and their respective counsel and, if applicable, counsel for the child. You must notify them within a reasonable time, in other words well before the next exercise of the access right.
On the same date, counsel for undertook to send you, on receipt, an excerpt from the <i>Minutes</i> setting out the terms and conditions for access ordered by the Court.
