In Courtroom 2.00

All applications for postponement (whether or not requiring representations) may be made before the special clerk on a practice day.

In advance, at any time, until 8:30 on the practice day

Applications for postponement with consent may be submitted until 8:30 a.m. on the day (Thursday):

- exceptionally, by phone, at 450-753-4855, extension 63066

After 8:30 a.m., you have to present your application in Courtroom 2.00.

Information required for an application for postponement

- file number;
- attorney's name and firm;
- contact phone number, if applicable;
- date of presentation of the motion;
- date of postponement or postponement *sine die*. If the motion is struck out, indicate the reason.

Important Up to three (3) postponements are accepted. After that, you must postpone *sine die* or be present in court to make representations before the special clerk in Courtroom 2.00.

٠	In family matters:	the application for postponement must be made on a Thursday and a postponement no
		less than 2 weeks is required

• In civil matters: the application for postponement must be made on a Thursday and a postponement no less than 2 weeks is required

<u>Reminder</u>

- In non-contentious matters: applications are presented on Wednesdays in Courtroom 2.20
- In bankruptcy cases: applications are presented on Fridays in Courtroom 2.00

Last, please ensure that the date requested is a practice day.
