NOTICE TO MEMBERS OF THE BAR OF LAVAL

CALLING OF THE PROVISIONAL ROLL

Beginning on December 10, 2013, a hearing may be fixed as follows for a case in which the file is complete.

1- Cases requiring 2 days or less

As soon as the file is complete and the required joint declaration has been produced for the case, the Master of the Rolls will communicate in writing with the parties to offer possible dates for a hearing and fix a date that suits all parties.

If a party fails to cooperate in the fixing of a date for the hearing, the other party may present a management notice under Article 4.1 C.C.P., on a practice day (Tuesday), asking the judge sitting in Courtroom 2.03 to fix a date for the case to be heard.

2- Cases requiring more than 2 days

As soon as the file is complete and the required joint declaration has been produced for the case, the parties will be duly convened by a letter from the Master of the Rolls to a calling of the “continuous provisional roll”, held every Tuesday in Courtroom 2.03, to fix a date for the case to be heard.
